



All Generations Foundation and All Generations Technology Bring Exploring the Arts & Science (EAS) to Atlanta for Free Intergenerational Innovation Experience

September 25 program at Metropolitan Library connects generations through arts, technology, creativity and hands-on exploration

ATLANTA, GA - September 2026 - All Generations Foundation (AGF), in partnership with All Generations Technology (AGT), will present **Exploring the Arts & Science (EAS) 2026** on Friday, September 25, at Metropolitan Library in Atlanta, offering a free intergenerational experience designed to connect creativity, technology, innovation and learning across generations.

Presented under the theme "**Imagine. Create. Innovate. Together.**" EAS creates opportunities for older adults, senior citizens and veterans to receive technology assistance, learn about technology in a comfortable environment, and participate in developing and beta testing new technologies. For younger participants, EAS offers an engaging way to explore new ideas, participate in interactive experiences and discover how the arts, science and technology increasingly intersect in everyday life.

"Exploring the Arts & Science was created from the belief that curiosity has no age limit," said **Felicia Seamon, Founder and Chair of All Generations Foundation and Owner of All Generations Technology, a technology startup.** "EAS brings generations together not simply to observe what is happening in science, technology, engineering and the arts, but to participate, create, test ideas and learn from one another. We want every person who walks through those doors to leave believing that innovation includes them and that their ideas, experiences and creativity have value."

The program will feature three primary areas of exploration: **ARTS, CREATE and BETA TEST**, offering experiences centered around creativity, technology and active participation.

Adults ages 55 and older will participate in the morning session from **11 a.m.-1 p.m. ET**, while the afternoon session from **3-5 p.m. ET** will engage youth and teens in creative and technology-centered exploration. Fulton County Library System's public calendar currently lists both EAS sessions at Metropolitan Library.

The **CREATE** experience will introduce participants to smart technology and innovation, including emerging concepts demonstrating how technology can intersect with products and everyday experiences.

Among the innovations being showcased is the evolving work of **Indigoz Shoes and Indigoz Insoles**, incorporating a footwear sensor technology concept developed by All Generations Technology. The developing concept explores how sensor technology integrated into footwear could provide insight into movement, pressure and mobility while preserving an emphasis on comfort and style.

"What makes EAS powerful is the intersection," said Michelle Nelson-Searcy, Board Member of All Generations Foundation and Founder of NxtLevel Promotion™. "We are creating an environment where generations, disciplines and ideas meet - where a young person exploring creative expression and an older adult engaging with emerging technology are both part of the same conversation about possibility. That is the kind of community-centered innovation we want to cultivate."

EAS extends beyond a traditional workshop experience. Participants will receive an **EAS Exploration Passport**, guiding them through the program as they explore activities and collect custom EAS stamps - creating a tangible record of their journey through creativity, discovery and innovation.

The program reflects All Generations Foundation's broader commitment to creating opportunities that connect generations through learning, engagement and shared experiences.

EAS will be held at **Metropolitan Library**, a branch of the Fulton County Library System, at **1332 Metropolitan Parkway SW in Atlanta. Atlanta Fulton County Recreation Authority (AFCRA)** is a sponsor of EAS 2026, supporting the program's community-centered mission and participant experience.
